MOTION NO. 5142

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to obtain the use of a facility for housing appropriate prisoners from the King County Jail.

WHEREAS, the County Executive has previously appointed an Executive Commission on the King County Jail to provide specific recommendations for solving overcrowding and other chronic problems related to the operation of the King County Jail, and

WHEREAS, this Executive Commission has issued its report including recommendations which are to be implemented in the near future, one of which recommends the utilization of an outside facility to relieve overcrowding at the main King County Jail;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Council hereby authorizes and directs the County Executive to undertake all necessary actions to obtain the use of an outside facility to help relieve the overcrowding of the King County Jail by housing appropriate prisoners from the main jail in said facility.

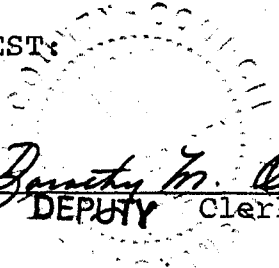
