MOTION NO!

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to submit a preliminary list of Park, Recreation and Open Space Projects to the Joint Citizens' Committee for the Study of Park, Recreation and Open Space Needs in King County.

WHEREAS, King County Council Motion No. 4778 authorizes establishment of a Joint Citizens' Committee to look into the Park, Recreation and Open Space future needs for Seattle and King County; and,

WHEREAS, the Joint Citizens' Committee has requested a preliminary list of Park, Recreation and Open Space Needs from the City of Seattle, all suburban cities, towns, and King County; and,

WHEREAS, a list has been compiled of the needs in King
County from community plans, cpaital improvement programs,
community sources, elected officials, and staff recommendations;
and,

WHEREAS, said list includes Park and Recreation projects, for both active as well as passive purposes, and Open Space projects which will also serve as surface water retention areas; and,

WHEREAS, said list is a preliminary listing of potential projects and will be refined as additional input from community sources is obtained, project cost information, both capital and operating, is refined, and priorities formulated; and,

WHEREAS, said preliminary list will be used by the Joint Committee (PRO/Parks) in assessing the total magnitude of the needs locally and regionally while the units of government are refining their list for final submittal.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY, That the County Executive is authorized and requested to submit the attached preliminary list of Park, Recreation and Open Space Projects to the Joint Citizens' Committee (PRO/Parks) with a transmittal letter indicating said list is tentative and King County will be refining said list for final submittal.
