MOTION NO. 5249

1 A MOTION relating to the Housing and Community
2 Development Block Grant and adopting an updated
3 Three-Year Plan for Community Development 1982 -
4 1984 for King County Block Grant Consortium.

4 WHEREAS, King County is a member of the Community Develop-
5 ment Block Grant Consortium; and

6 WHEREAS, all members of the Community Development Block
7 Grant Consortium are required to adopt a Three-Year Plan for
8 Community Development; and

9 WHEREAS, King County has adopted the Three-Year Plan for
10 Community Development 1981 - 1983 by Motion No. 4945; and

11 WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has approved the Block
12 Grant Consortium Plan for Community Development 1981 - 1983 for
13 King County; and

14 WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development
15 required that entitlement jurisdictions prepare a three-year
16 strategy for community development funds; and

17 WHEREAS, the Department of Housing and Urban Development
18 requires an updated plan to be prepared for the period 1982 - 84;
19 and

20 WHEREAS, the King County Executive has submitted the updated
21 Block Grant Consortium Three-Year Plan for Community Development
22 1982 - 84;

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

24 A. The attached updated Block Grant Consortium Three-Year
25 Plan for Community Development 1982 - 84 is hereby adopted to
26 amend the existing plan and to govern the planning process and
27 development of the 1982 - 84 Community Development Program;

28 Provided that:

29 The section entitled "Program Management" (Page 11 of the
30 Draft Plan) is amended to delete sub-paragraphs 1, 2 and 3 and
31 substitute the following language:

- 32 1. The status of Needs and Joint projects will be reviewed
33 by the Joint Policy Committee six months after funds

1 become available. Projects not yet begun may be
 2 reevaluated by the JPC for possible reduction or can-
 3 cellation. Such determination will be made in the form
 4 of a recommendation to the King County Council in
 5 keeping with the Consortium's Cooperation Agreement.
 6 Any funds resulting from such Council action will revert
 7 to the fund from which they originated.

8 2. Needs and Joint projects which are not begun within the
 9 program year for which the funds were made available may
 10 be recommended by the JPC to the County Council for can-
 11 cellation. Funds resulting from such Council action will
 12 revert to the fund from which they originated.

13 B. The regional earmarks for the 1982 program year shall
 14 be computed using the formula that was used for the 1981 program
 15 year.
