WHEREAS, King County has recently developed said park and opened it for public recreational usage, and


WHEREAS, the most prominent features of the site are two ponds, and

WHEREAS, the community has suggested the park name reflect those features,


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County
