

MOTION NO. 5384

2 A MOTION relating to a system of reimbursement
3 for the Prosecuting Attorney and Assessor, for
4 transportation.

5 WHEREAS, the King County Charter, Section 220.20 provides
6 that the County Council shall establish the compensation to be
7 paid to all County officers and employees and shall provide for
8 the reimbursement of expenses, and

9 WHEREAS, Chapter 3.28 of the King County Code, provides that
10 the County Council may establish a system of reimbursement for
11 the use of privately owned vehicles used in connection with County
12 business in lieu of permanently assigned County vehicles, and

13 WHEREAS, it is the intention of the King County Council to
14 seek to minimize the number of County-owned and operated vehicles;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

16 A. The Prosecuting Attorney and the Assessor are expected
17 to exercise prudent judgement in incurring reimbursable expenses on
18 official County business. Excessive or unnecessary expenses shall
19 not be approved or reimbursed.


20 B. Reimbursable transportation expenses shall include the
21 cost of all actual and necessary official travel on railroads,
22 airlines, ships, buses, private and rental automobiles and other
23 usual means of conveyance.

24 C. Reimbursement for the use of privately owned vehicles in
25 connection with County business shall be allowed at the current
26 rate per mile prescribed by County ordinance. In lieu of such
27 reimbursement, the Prosecuting Attorney and the Assessor may, at
28 their individual option, be compensated on a monthly basis for the
29 use of privately owned vehicles used in connection with County
30 business. To implement this alternative, the Administrator of
31 the Council shall periodically, and no less than annually,
32 ascertain the average monthly costs to the Motor Pool for the
33

1 maintenance and operation of equivalent vehicles within the fleet.
2 Ninety percent of that figure shall be the maximum allowable
3 compensation.


