MOTION NO. 5520

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to effect the transfer of a 1,000 square foot triangle to the City of Redmond for park purposes.

WHEREAS, King County acquired the West 1/2, Tract 5, Eastside Gardens, Volume 12 of Plats, page 68, on August 10, 1970, pursuant to an agreement with the State Department of Transportation under which the State built an equestrian overcrossing of S.R. 520 in conjunction with N.E. 60th Street in exchange for the County donating that portion of the S.R. 520 right of way within the West 1/2 of said Tract 5, and

WHEREAS, there is now a small triangular remainder (1,000 square feet, more or less) from the West 1/2 of said Tract 5 lying Westerly of S.R. 520 and Southerly of N.E. 60th Street which is no longer needed by the County and is within the City of Redmond, and

WHEREAS, the City of Redmond has requested that King County transfer ownership of this small triangle to the City of Redmond for use as a roadside park;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized and directed to execute the deed necessary to effect the transfer of said small triangular remainder to the City of Redmond in consideration of the City's promise to operate the subject property as a roadside park in perpetuity.
