

MOTION NO. **5553**

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to effect the transfer of Valley Memorial Park to the City of Carnation.

WHEREAS, King County now owns a park known as Valley Memorial Park, adjoining the city limits of Carnation, Washington, and

WHEREAS, the City of Carnation has expressed a willingness to develop, maintain, and use the subject property as a public park and recreation site for the citizens of Carnation and King County in exchange for the transfer of said property to the City of Carnation; and

WHEREAS, the County Council finds that it is no longer necessary for King County to own and manage this park property adjoining the City of Carnation;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The County Executive is authorized and directed to execute any agreements and deeds necessary to effect the transfer of Valley Memorial Park to the City of Carnation in consideration of the City's promise to develop, maintain, and operate the subject property as a public park and recreation facility for the use of all citizens of King County in perpetuity.
