MOTION NO. 5569

A MOTION to reconsider pursuant to KCC 20.24.250 the approval of the proposed plat of Forest Trail (BALD File No. 1179-26).

WHEREAS, the King County Council on August 16, 1982 considered a land use appeal on the proposed plat of Forest Trail (BALD File No. 1179-26), and

WHEREAS, the proposed plat of Forest Trail was approved by Ordinance 6103, and

WHEREAS, in the consideration of the proposed plat the Council directed the Deputy Hearing Examiner to notify the Building and Land Development Division (BALD) of possible code violations at the Burks' machine shop which is located near the plat, and

WHEREAS, investigation of the machine shop by BALD has determined it is a legal nonconforming use, and

WHEREAS, this will have the practical effect of permitting single family homes next to an industrial use, and

WHEREAS, the conditions of approval for the proposed plat of Forest Trail did not address possible impacts from the machine shop, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to ensure the single family residential use is not adversely impacted by the machine shop, and

WHEREAS, KCC 20.24.250(A) permits reconsideration of any action after it has become final when it was based in whole or part on erroneous facts or information;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:
Approval of the proposed plat of Forest Trail (BALD File No. 1179-26) is hereby reconsidered pursuant to KCC 20.24.250(A) to address possible impacts from an adjacent machine shop which has been determined to be a legal nonconforming land use.
