MOTION NO. 5585

A MOTION requesting the Director of Intergovernmental Relations to transmit to the State Legislature an Audit Report Finding and Recommendation concerning State laws relating to Sheriff's Real Property Sales.

WHEREAS, the King County Council commends the State Legislature for its revision in 1981 of State laws relating to Sheriff's Sales, and

WHEREAS, the Office of the King County Auditor has conducted a management audit of Sheriff's Real Property Sales (October 1982, Report No. 82-9), and

WHEREAS, the Audit found that State law requires some duplicative and unnecessary notification procedures in the Sheriff's Sale process, and

WHEREAS, the Audit concluded that revisions of State law could make the Sheriff's Sale process more efficient without lessening its effectiveness; and,

WHEREAS, the King County Council concurs with the Audit Finding and Recommendation, and desires that the State Legislature consider revisions to State law relating to Sheriff's Sales;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Director of Intergovernmental Relations is hereby requested to transmit to the State Legislature, for its consideration, Finding No. 3, and the accompanying Recommendation, of the Management Audit of Sheriff's Real Property Sales, October 1982, Report No. 82-9.
