

MOTION NO. 5604

1 A MOTION remanding to the Zoning and Subdivision
2 Examiner the application by King County for an
3 unclassified use permit for a solid waste transfer
4 station, known as the Northshore Transfer Station,
5 designated Building and Land Development Division
6 File No. 152-79-U.

7 WHEREAS, on August 26, 1982 the King County Superior Court, in Cause
8 No. 80-2-08830-1, remanded to King County the application made by King
9 County for an unclassified use permit for a solid waste transfer station,
10 designated Building and Land Development Division File No. 152-79-U, and

11 WHEREAS, the order of remand requires additional findings by the Council,
12 for which the Council desires to receive the recommendations of the Zoning
13 and Subdivision Examiner;

14 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

15 A. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner is directed to review the
16 record established in the public hearing previously conducted on the subject
17 application, and determine:

18 1. Whether the conditions imposed upon the subject application can be
19 identified by a specific document and page number in the environmental
20 documents produced in accordance with the State Environmental Act; and

21 2. Whether or not the environmental impact statement submitted in this
22 matter is adequate.

23 B. The Zoning and Subdivision Examiner is authorized, if he deems it
24 reasonable and necessary to do so: to reopen the public hearing on the
25 subject matter for the introduction of supplemental environmental documents
26 or other additional evidence; and to allow additional written or oral
27 argument by any party.

28 BE IT FURTHER MOVED:

29 If the Zoning and Subdivision Examiner determines that the environmental
30 impact statement prepared for this action was not adequate, the examiner
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1 shall identify the areas of inadequacy and the Department of Public Works
2 shall revise or supplement the previously prepared environmental impact
3 statement to address the areas of inadequacy identified by the examiner, and
4 the public hearing shall be re-opened by the examiner after a revised or
5 supplemental environmental impact statement is circulated in compliance with
6 the State Environmental Policy Act.
