

MOTION NO. 5622

A MOTION authorizing the deployment of County resources outside of County boundaries in an emergency, and authorizing Interlocal Cooperation Agreements.

WHEREAS, the King County Executive is the chief law enforcement officer of the County, and

WHEREAS, the laws of the state of Washington currently limit County law enforcement officials' jurisdiction to the confines of their County boundaries, and

WHEREAS, emergencies requiring the application of law enforcement resources do not recognize geographical boundaries, and

WHEREAS, from time to time emergencies have arisen and will arise in neighboring counties which exceed the capabilities of resources available to the officials of those counties, and

WHEREAS, King County has been and will be from time to time asked to assist other counties in dealing with such emergencies, and

WHEREAS, RCW 39.34, the Interlocal Cooperation Act, enables local government units to cooperate with other jurisdictions to provide resources to meet the needs of other local government units,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County Executive, by and through his Director of Public Safety and Ex-Officio Sheriff, is authorized to deploy King County resources outside of the geographical boundaries of said County in response to requests for assistance from other appropriate law enforcement officials to meet emergencies,
