

MOTION NO. 5759

A MOTION authorizing the County Executive to Submit a grant application to the Economic Development Administration for improvements to public facilities in the Kenmore Business District Development Area.

WHEREAS, the Emergency Jobs Act, Public Law 98-8, provides funds to aid economic development to offset present business and plant closures, and

WHEREAS, the Kenmore Business District is identified as a Community Center for economic development by the King County Department of Planning and Community Development, and

WHEREAS, a lack of capacity in public facilities for water supply and road traffic circulation is presently restricting development of commercial, industrial, and retail business in the Kenmore Business District, and

WHEREAS, improvements necessary to public facilities in the Kenmore Business District are itemized in the Northshore Community Plan, and

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed for public facilities in the Kenmore Business District are in accord with the objectives of the Emergency Jobs Act relating to economic development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County Executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$950,000 to the Economic Development Administration for improvements to water and road systems in the Kenmore Business District on behalf of King County;


