MOTION NO. 5900

A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to enter into contractual agreements with various King County suburban jurisdictions to provide basic public health services to those jurisdictions in 1984.

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 70.05 and RCW 70.46, it is the responsibility of all cities and towns in Washington state to provide "basic public health services" to their residents or to purchase such services under contract;

WHEREAS, WAC 248-90-990 defines the "basic public health services" to be provided to Washington state residents as well as "optional public health services" which may be provided;

WHEREAS, pursuant to proposed contractual agreements, various cities and towns will reimburse the King County Department of Public Health for their share of the cost of providing basic public health services in order to assure an adequate standard for basic public health services throughout King County;

WHEREAS, pursuant to proposed contractual agreements, the King County Department of Public Health shall provide additional public health services throughout King County in order to preserve, promote, and improve the public health of all residents of King County;


WHEREAS, the proposed contractual agreements represent the culmination of the efforts of the Health Services Contract Task Force who devoted numerous hours of study, review, and discussion to develop agreements that are equitable and fair.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County Executive is hereby authorized to enter into contractual agreements with cities and towns pursuant to RCW 70.05 and RCW 70.46 to provide basic public health services to those jurisdictions.
