

MOTION NO. 5909

A MOTION authorizing an interlocal cooperation agreement for an exchange of personnel with the Attorney General's Office.

WHEREAS, the King County department of public safety is assembling a task force to address more directly the homicide cases known as the "Green River Murders", and

WHEREAS, the office of the attorney general of the State of Washington has in its employ an investigator with special expertise in such matters, and

WHEREAS, the King County prosecuting attorney's office has requested investigative support from the attorney general's office in this matter, and

WHEREAS, both the attorney general and the King County department of public safety are agreeable to a temporary exchange of investigators at cost.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to enter into an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with the State of Washington to facilitate an exchange of personnel for a limited period of time for an investigation.
