

MOTION NO. 5921

A MOTION related to the fiscal management of solid waste; authorizing the county executive to make grant applications for all eligible items in the 1984 Five-Year Maintenance Plan and the Operating Plan.

WHEREAS, the King County council by its ordinance No. 5497, dated November 28, 1983, adopted the 1984 Annual Budget for solid waste to meet construction and operational planning needs, and

WHEREAS, certain projects within the adopted budget may be eligible for partial funding under the State Referendum 39 Grant Program, and

WHEREAS, the King County council in adopting the solid waste budget directed the executive to apply for Referendum 39 funding for all eligible items included in the 1984 Five-Year Maintenance Plan and the Operating Plan;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The King County executive is authorized to apply for all grant monies available from the State Department of Ecology to help support the cost of solid waste projects listed below:

1. Hobart Landfill fence
2. Enumclaw Landfill fence
3. Vashon Landfill fence
4. Cedar Falls Landfill fence
5. Houghton Transfer Station fence
6. Cedar Hills truck and equipment wash facility
7. Cedar Hills Landfill fence road
8. Operating Plan for the 1982 Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan

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The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and enter into the execute such contracts as are required by the grantor.
