WHEREAS, the King County Council does not have to let Ed Donohoe off the hook easily.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. The County Executive, as chief health officer, is hereby requested to authenticate Mr. Donohoe's birth records to determine his eligibility for retirement.


B. Provided the records show his eligibility for retirement, the County Council extends its congratulations to Ed and wishes him the best in the years ahead.
