A MOTION recognizing the community activities of Mel Ferron and naming the Marine Hills to Redondo Walkway the Mel Ferron Walkway.

WHEREAS, Mel Ferron who was President of the Redondo Community Club for more than ten years, and

WHEREAS, he was instrumental in forging a consensus from divergent interests which allowed the development of the Redondo Waterfront Park benefiting the citizens of the community and the region by providing access to a waterfront facility which otherwise would have been developed for private usage, and

WHEREAS, since 1979 he has spearheaded the efforts of the community to have the Marine Hills to Redondo Walkway constructed, and

WHEREAS, his tenacity and tough negotiating skills developed as a union organizer served him well in this endeavor, and

WHEREAS, he has spent countless hours in the service of the Redondo community and the citizens of King County, and

WHEREAS, the completed walkway will serve as a safe route for children going to the Nautilus School from Redondo;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Marine Hills to Redondo Walkway is named the Mel Ferron Walkway in recognition of his years of service to the citizens of Redondo and King County.
