6 A MOTION recognizing May 20 - 26, 1984 as
7 National Public Works Week in King County

8
9 WHEREAS, public works services provided by King County
10 include programs for the design, construction and maintenance
11 of a 2,639 mile road network and a system of 217 bridges,
12 operation of King County International Airport, one of the
13 busiest in the nation with 392,180 takeoffs and landings
14 in 1983, operation of a solid waste system that disposed of
15 760,000 tons of solid waste in 1983, operation and control of
16 a surface water drainage system that includes more than 900
17 miles of underground pipelines and 30,000 catchbasins, operation
18 of five community sewer districts and management of the county's
19 motor pool and its equipment rental fund, and

20 WHEREAS, the King County department of public works is
21 responsible for a \$100 million Capital Improvement Program that
22 over the next six years will provide for road system improvements,
23 solid waste system improvements, improvements at King County
24 International Airport, and improvements to the surface water
25 management and flood control system, and

26 WHEREAS, the health, safety and comfort of our community
27 greatly depend on these facilities and services, and

28 WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these facilities,
29 as well as their planning, design and construction are vitally
30 dependent upon the efforts and skill of public works officials
31 and employees;

3 The King County council hereby recognizes the week of
