

MOTION NO. 6033

A MOTION to grant an electrical power system easement to Puget Sound Power and Light Company in Council District No. 6.

WHEREAS, Puget Sound Power and Light Company has made application for the right to construct, operate and maintain an electrical power system with the necessary appurtenances over, under, upon and across the land described herein, and

WHEREAS, the said electrical power system crosses lands which are owned by King County, and

WHEREAS, King County will be a user of electricity at its public works Cedar Falls transfer station, and

WHEREAS, this transmission line will improve service to the residents of King County in this area, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it would be to the county's advantage to grant Puget Sound Power and Light Company the requested easement for a consideration of mutual benefits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary electrical power system easement granting to Puget Sound Power and Light Company an easement for an electrical power system with the necessary appurtenances over, under, upon and across the following described property, situate in King County, Washington:

A thirty (30) foot easement and right of way, under, across, and over a strip of land lying three (3) feet right and twenty seven (27) feet left of the following described traverse line situated in King County, Washington:

Beginning at a concrete monument, the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 27, Township 23 North, Range 8 East, Wm.; thence South 01°04'38" West along the east section line a distance 536.29 feet to the TRUE POINT OF BEGINNING; thence North 37°23'25" West a distance of 172.09 feet; thence North 31°12'39" West a distance of 198.77 feet; thence North 35°54'35" West a distance of 107.42 feet; thence North 49°08'00" West a distance of 227.93 feet to a point on the north line of the southeast quarter of said section which bears North 89°09'24" West a distance of 453.00 feet from the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of Section 27, Township 23 North, Range 8 East, W.M., North 54°39'38" West a distance of 70.65 feet; thence North 59°20'17" West a distance of
