A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application for funding to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Rental Rehabilitation Program and enter into interlocal agreements and/or memorandums of understanding necessary to implement the program.

WHEREAS, the federal government through the adoption and administration of the Housing and Urban-Rural Recovery Act of 1983 will make Rental Rehabilitation Program funds available to the King County community development block grant (CDBG) consortium for expenditure during the 1985 and 1986 federal fiscal years, and

WHEREAS, the federal government through the regulations for the Rental Rehabilitation Program requires King County to submit an application for the funds to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by review of data from the 1980 U. S. Census, the King County 1981 housing condition survey, and available data on rents in King County that neighborhoods and properties exist in King County that meet the eligibility requirements of the federal regulations for the Rental Rehabilitation Program, and

WHEREAS, the Rental Rehabilitation Program provides section 8 existing housing certificates and vouchers for eligible low income tenants of properties rehabilitated through the program to assist them with monthly housing costs, and

WHEREAS, section 8 existing housing certificates and vouchers are administered through local housing authorities, and

WHEREAS, the federal government through the regulations for the Rental Rehabilitation Program requires a memorandum of understanding between local governments and housing authorities in order to participate in the program and receive the rehabilitation funds and section 8 certificates and vouchers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit 1985 and 1986 program applications to the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for the Rental Rehabilitation Program.
- B. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into interlocal agreements with CDBG consortium cities if necessary to implement the program and to enter into the required memorandum(s) of understanding with the housing authority, County of King, to administer the section 8 existing housing certificates and vouchers provided in the Rental Rehabilitation Program.
- C. The housing and community development division is directed to prepare proposed rental rehabilitation program rules and procedures for submittal to the council with the appropriation ordinance for this grant. The required rules and procedures will, at a minimum, contain standards and procedures which address the following issues: Lender selection, landlord selection, project selection, and compliance with federal requirements, including continued low and moderate income occupancy, tenant assistance policy, and affirmative marketing.
- D. The grant appropriation ordinance will contain language which redistributes presently programmed CDBG rental rehabilition funds sufficient to administer this program.
