A MOTION creating a sister county affiliation between King County and Hwasong County, Republic of Korea.

WHEREAS, the Republic of Korea and the United States of America are both Pacific rim nations, and

WHEREAS, both nations have an interest in increased maritime trade and other ties between the two countries, and

WHEREAS, a sister county relationship will promote mutual understanding through exchange visits of students and others, and

WHEREAS, the resulting trade, economic and cultural ties will further promote understanding between citizens of the two countries and provide opportunities for the exchange of technical assistance, and

WHEREAS, a sister county relationship would enhance the relationship between the two countries and promote the cause of world peace;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The Council does hereby resolve to create a sister county affiliation with the county of Hwasong, Republic of Korea.
