2 A MOTION adopting the Amended 1983-1985 Housing As-  
3 sistance Plan and 1985 Annual Action Plan and auth-  
4 orizing the King County Executive to submit the  
Plans to the United States Department of Housing and  
Urban Development.

5 WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended,  
6 establishes a program of financial assistance to local governments for the  
7 development of viable urban communities through the provision of decent hous-  
8 ing and a suitable living environment and expanded economic opportunities,  
9 primarily for persons of low and moderate income, and,

10 WHEREAS, the Act provides that the three year Housing Assistance Plan and  
11 Annual Action Plan are the focus for mutual cooperation between local jurisd-  
12 ictions and United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD)  
13 housing programs for carrying out locally determined housing strategies, and,

14 WHEREAS, King County is in a consortium with twenty-four cities and  
15 towns, and

16 WHEREAS, the Joint Policy Committee has reviewed and approved the Hous-  
17 ing Assistance Plan and the Annual Action Plan, required by federal law to be  
18 submitted as part of the community development block grant program, and

19 WHEREAS, the King County council has held public hearings to hear the  
20 views of citizens on housing and community development needs,

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

22 The Amended 1983-1985 Housing Assistance Plan and 1985 Annual Action  
23 Plan are adopted as part of the overall community development program.

1 A. The Council of King County finds and determines that this Housing  
2 Assistance Plan reflects current conditions for housing assistance in King  
3 County.

4 B. The Council of King County finds and determines that this Annual  
5 Housing Action Plan reflects the needs and priorities for housing assistance  
6 in King County and that it shall supersede the 1984 Annual Housing Action Plan  
7 after adoption by the council and approval by HUD.

8 C. The King County executive is hereby authorized to submit the Amended  
9 1983-1985 Housing Assistance Plan and 1985 Annual Plan to HUD.

10 D. The King County executive is also authorized to use this Annual  
11 Housing Action Plan in reviewing and ranking projects proposed for federal  
12 housing assistance under Section 213 of the Housing and Community Development  
13 Act of 1974, as amended.

14 E. It is the county's intention that federal housing agencies comply  
15 with both the spirit and the letter of the goals and priorities stated in this  
16 Housing Assistance Plan and Housing Action Plan when making program alloca-  
17 tions and conducting other activities in the county.
