A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to grant an easement in favor of the City of Seattle.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle plans to install and maintain electrical transmission lines on certain lands owned by King County, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle would pay King County \$1,300.00 as consideration for an easement over, across, and upon these lands, and

WHEREAS, it is determined to be necessary and in the best interests of the citizens of King County that this easement be granted;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary electrical transmission line easement granting to the City of Seattle the easement over, across, and upon the following described property:

Those portions of lot 16, block 1, Green Lake Five Acre Tracts, as recorded in volume 11 of plats, page 72, records of King County, Washington; tracts 66, 67 and 69, Murphy's Interurban Acres, as recorded in volume 17 of plats, page 83, records of said county; and vacated Corliss Avenue North, adjoining, vacated under file number V-1221, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west margin of Corliss Avenue North, 167.037 feet north of the north margin of North 163rd Street; thence North 24°22'47" East 246.44 feet; thence North 03°31'38" East 195.05 feet; thence North 00°57'47" West 674.68 feet to the south margin of North 167th Street; thence North 87°37'05" West along said south margin to a point which is 1.524 feet west of the northeast corner of said Tract 69; thence South 02°58'45" East 678.725 feet; thence South 00°54'07" West 185.316 feet; thence South 21°43'57" West 161.056 feet to said west margin; thence southerly along said west margin 84.103 feet to the point of beginning.
