MOTION NO. 6158

A MOTION authorizing the execution of an agreement under the Interlocal Cooperation Act, Revised Code of Washington Chapter 39.34 to provide loaned personnel assistance to the City of Auburn.

WHEREAS, King County ("the county"), State of Washington, department of public safety has a number of highly trained and experienced personnel skilled in police science and police managerial skills, and

WHEREAS, the City of Auburn, State of Washington, ("the city") has immediate need of a police supervisor to act as its Chief of Police on a temporary basis, and

WHEREAS, the county is willing to provide a police supervisor, County Police Lieutenant William E. Stockham, to the city on a temporary basis to act as Chief of the city's police department, and

WHEREAS, the city is willing to pay the county an amount equivalent to Lieutenant Stockham's salary for the duration of the period during which he acts as the city's Chief of Police;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to contract with the City of Auburn to provide payment to the county of an amount equivalent to the salary of Lieutenant William E. Stockham during that period in which he acts as Chief of Police for the city.
