A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$150,000 to support a program for Hazard Assessment of Abandoned Landfills, Grant File No. 427.

WHEREAS, the Public Health Service, Center for Disease Control is empowered to make grants to support occupational and environmental health and safety programs, and

WHEREAS, Hazard Assessment of Abandoned Landfills will assist the county to determine the health and safety problems arising from abandoned landfills, and

WHEREAS, the council of King County finds that provision of such services is in the public interest, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

- A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for funds in the approximate amount of \$150,000 to the Public Health Service,

 Center for Disease Control, for a program for Hazard Assessment of Abandoned

 Landfills on behalf of King County;
- B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
- C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
- D. The Public Health Service, Center for Disease Control, is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.

PROVIDED THAT:

Upon completion of the abandoned landfill study authorized by this motion, the executive shall submit a final report to the council which identifies and evaluates potential environmental and public health hazards of abandoned landfills and includes recommendations for mitigating any such hazards.
