A motion authorizing King County to enter into an inter-local agreement with Lane County, Oregon to acquire a maintenance management information system, and committing to an estimated expenditure of \$17,500.00 in 1985.

WHEREAS, King County is implementing a computer assisted roads maintenance management program within the Department of Public Works, and

WHEREAS, the Lane County Department of Public Works has developed a computerized road maintenance management information system which, with modification, would meet requirements of the roads maintenance management program in King County, and

WHEREAS, Lane County has expressed a willingness to assist King County by providing computer software and other technical assistance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Pursuant to RCW 39.34, Interlocal Cooperation Act, the county executive is hereby authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with Lane County, Oregon to acquire and modify the maintenance management information system and to commit to project costs in 1985 in the amount of approximately \$17,500.00.
