2 A MOTION authorizing the King County Executive to submit a
3 grant application to the United States Economic Develop-
4 ment Administration to fund public facility improvements
in the Kenmore Commercial/Industrial Center.

5 WHEREAS, the United States Economic Development Administration, under the
6 authority of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965, Public Law
7 89-136, provides funding for public improvements which stimulate long-term
8 private sector investment and job creation, and

9 WHEREAS, the King County Northshore Community Plan identifies Kenmore as
10 a commercial and industrial center for economic development, and

11 WHEREAS, inadequate public water supply and road facilities are presently
12 restricting private commercial and industrial development in the Kenmore
13 Commercial/Industrial Center, and

14 WHEREAS, the King County department of public works, in coordination with
15 the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District and the Kenmore
16 business community, is proposing water and road improvements, known as the
17 Kenmore Redevelopment Project, to stimulate private sector investment and
18 job creation in the Kenmore Commercial/Industrial Center, and

19 WHEREAS, the Kenmore Redevelopment Project is consistent with the
20 Northshore Community Plan, the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water
21 District Plan, and the Public Works and Economic Development Act, and

22 WHEREAS, the Northeast Lake Washington Sewer and Water District Board of
23 Commissioners has enacted Resolution 1983-6-2 endorsing their participation in
24 the Kenmore Redevelopment Project, and

25 WHEREAS, the King County council has previously enacted legislation in
26 the form of King County Motions 5193 and 5759 in support of water and road
27 improvements to stimulate economic development in the Kenmore Commercial/
28 Industrial Center, and

29 WHEREAS, the 1985-1990 King County Capital Improvements Program includes
30 \$232,744 in road improvements for the Kenmore Redevelopment Project, and

31 WHEREAS, the Central Puget Sound Economic Development District on May 17,
32 1984 identified the Kenmore Redevelopment Project as its number one regional
33 priority for 1985 funding by the Economic Development Administration, and

1 WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration on February 6, 1985
2 formally invited King County to submit a grant application by March 18, 1985
3 to fund the Kenmore Redevelopment Project.

4 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

5 A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application
6 for funds in the amount of \$510,021 to the Economic Development Administration
7 for improvements to water and road systems in the Kenmore Commercial/
8 Industrial Center on behalf of King County;

9 B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute
10 such applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by
11 the grantor; and


12 C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and exe-
13 cute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project.
