MOTION NO. 6247

A MOTION authorizing an interlocal agreement between King County and the City of Des Moines for the distribution of local option boat tax revenues, and authorizing the County Executive to execute such an interlocal agreement.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 82.49 Revised Code of Washington (RCW), King County has enacted a local option boat tax applicable to certain vessels moored or stored in King County, and

WHEREAS, Chapter 82.49 RCW provides that such tax revenue shall be used only for administration and enforcement of boating safety, search and rescue operations concerning boating, and boating patrols, and

WHEREAS, the county desires to transfer to the city a portion of such tax revenues to be used for boating safety services in an area which the county cannot feasibly serve with existing personnel and equipment, and

WHEREAS, the city desires to use such revenues to support marine safety services most needed by vessels operating in the vicinity of the city;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Pursuant to RCW 39.34.080, it is hereby agreed that the county executive is authorized to enter into an interlocal agreement with the City of Des Moines for the distribution of local option boat tax revenues.
