2 A MOTION to set the date for a hearing upon the Maintenance  
3 Assessment Roll for Road Improvement District No. 99 for  
4 street lights in the plat of Twin Lakes Park.

5 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance 7193 created King County Road Improvement  
6 District No. 99 for maintaining, energizing and operating street lights within  
7 the plat of Twin Lakes Park: The improvement has been completed and the cost is  
8 now known, and

9 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 7193 directed the director of the  
10 department of public works to prepare and file with the King County clerk of the  
11 council, a maintenance assessment roll for the maintenance assessment to be  
12 levied against the property included in Road Improvement District No. 99: The  
13 maintenance assessment roll has been prepared and filed with the clerk of the  
14 King County council;

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

16 A. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090, the hearing upon the  
17 maintenance assessment roll for King County Road Improvement District No.  
18 99 shall be scheduled for August 5, 1985, at 9:30 a.m.

19 B. The King County council will sit as a board of equalization for the  
20 purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at aforesaid hearing or  
21 hearings and will consider such objections as are made thereto or any part  
22 thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said roll or  
23 any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made  
24 de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable, and then proceed to  
25 confirm the same by ordinance.

26 C. The clerk of the King County council is hereby directed to give notice  
27 of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed owners of the property whose  
28 name appears thereon by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen days before  
29 the date fixed for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at the address  
30 of such owner as shown on the tax rolls of the King County office of finance; in  
31 addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a  
32 newspaper of general circulation in the County if the paper is published weekly


1 or five (5) times if the paper is published daily. Such notices shall specify  
 2 the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may  
 3 desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same  
 4 with the clerk of the council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
