MOTION NO. 6323

A MOTION authorizing the Executive to enter into an agreement between King County and METRO regarding the Renton Effluent Transfer System for technical assistance and services, and restoration and mitigation projects.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Metropolitan Seattle (METRO) is proposing to construct an Effluent Transfer System (ETS) for the purpose of diverting effluent from the Renton Sewage Treatment Plant directly into Puget Sound at Duwamish Head, and

WHEREAS, the alignment for the ETS has been established by METRO Resolution No. 4339, which requires portions of the project to be constructed within areas of unincorporated King County in the Duwamish Valley, and

WHEREAS, by said Resolution No. 4339, the executive director of METRO was directed to work in cooperation with King County, among others on facility design and implementation, including identification and implementation of adequate and timely measures to mitigate adverse construction and environmental impacts resulting from the pipeline project upon public parks, public rights-of-way, traffic, drainage and the quality of life in neighborhoods through which the pipeline passes, and

WHEREAS, the schedule for the design and construction of the Renton Effluent Transfer System within King County requires timely review and approval and other technical support services to be provided by various King County departments, and

WHEREAS, by Motion No. 6298 passed July 1, 1985, the county council found the provisions of a draft agreement regarding the Renton Effluent Transfer Station as acceptable guidelines for negotiations between the county and METRO, and

1           WHEREAS, by Resolution 4687 adopted July 18, 1985, the METRO  
2 council approved the agreement in substantially the same form as  
3 found acceptable by King County Motion 6298, and authorized the  
4 METRO executive director to execute the contract, and

5           WHEREAS, the King County council considers the provisions of  
6 the agreement to be in the best interests of the parties  
7 concerned;

8           NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

9           The county executive is hereby authorized to enter into and  
10 execute the attached agreement with the Municipality of  
11 Metropolitan Seattle regarding technical assistance and services,  
12 and restoration and mitigation in conjunction with the  
13 construction of the Renton Effluent Transfer System through  
14 unincorporated King County.
