

MOTION NO. 6353

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds in the approximate amount of \$150,000 to support acquisition of the Kenmore to Bothell segment of the Burke-Gilman Trail, Grant File 518.

WHEREAS, the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation is empowered to make grants to support acquisition of recreational and park facilities, and

WHEREAS, the acquisition of Kenmore to Bothell segment of the Burke-Gilman Trail will assist the county in meeting the needs of the public for recreational facilities and close the missing link in the Burke-Gilman to the Sammamish River Trail, and

WHEREAS, the council recognizes an obligation to provide the amount of \$200,000 from the proceeds of Park and Recreation Bond sales as a cash match in support of the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make applications for funds in the approximate amount of \$150,000 to the State Interagency Committee for Outdoor Recreation for acquisition of the Kenmore to Bothell segment of the Burke-Gilman Trail.

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such applications and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;


C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;
