A MOTION authorizing the execution of an agreement with the City of Carnation to share Public Safety communications facilities.

WHEREAS, King County, State of Washington, discharges its responsibility to furnish police service to its citizens by its department of public safety ("the department") under the authority of the county executive, and

WHEREAS, consolidation of law enforcement communications facilities can reduce the cost of providing E911 services, and

WHEREAS, the city of Carnation ("the City") desires to avail itself of the law enforcement communications facilities of the department during certain hours of operation, and

WHEREAS, the City is not readily able to furnish such service without incurring costs in excess of those necessary to reimburse the department for providing that service, and

WHEREAS, the City is willing to reimburse the department for such service and the department is willing to provide that service;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is hereby authorized to contract with the City of Carnation for the furnishing of law enforcement communications facilities by the department of public safety.
