MOTION NO. 6386

A MOTION authorizing the transfer of certain
King County property to the City of Seattle

WHEREAS, King County now owns property within the city limits of Seattle bounded by South Hardy Street, Stanley Avenue South, Albro Place South, and 13th Avenue South, and

WHEREAS, said property is to be developed into a park by the county, known as the Ruby Chow Park, and

WHEREAS, King County must obtain a City of Seattle Street Use Permit in order to make certain street improvements in conjunction with the said project along certain portions of the perimeter streets and must transfer title to those portions to the City of Seattle in order to be legally able to make the said improvements, and

WHEREAS, the county council finds it is not necessary for the county to own and manage the property, and it is in the interest of the county to convey the same to the City of Seattle for the purpose of making street improvements adjacent to the project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized and directed to execute agreements and deeds necessary to effect the transfer of a portion of the perimeter of the said property along South Hardy Street and a part of Stanley Avenue South to the City of Seattle in order to obtain a Street Use Permit to make the said street improvements.
