

MOTION NO. 6409

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds to support the central pit construction at Cedar Hills Landfill, Grant File No. 525.

WHEREAS, the solid waste disposal area presently available at the Cedar Hills Landfill is substantially utilized and additional disposal area will soon be needed, and

WHEREAS, additional solid waste disposal area can be provided by construction of a central pit at Cedar Hills Landfill, and

WHEREAS, solid waste disposal projects are eligible for funding from State Referendum 39 bond proceeds through the Department of Ecology;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for Referendum 39 funds in the approximate amount of \$4.65 million to the Department of Ecology for central pit construction at Cedar Hills Landfill on behalf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;
