

MOTION NO. 6410

A MOTION authorizing the county executive to make a grant application for funds to support Energy/Resource Recovery, Grant File No. 526.

WHEREAS, the potential of Energy/Resource Recovery from solid waste has been under review by the county for several years, and

WHEREAS, an Energy/Resource Recovery system would enable the life of the regional landfill at Cedar Hills to be extended, and

WHEREAS, the Energy/Resource Recovery project is eligible for funding from State Referendum 39 bond proceeds through the Department of Ecology;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

A. The King County executive is hereby authorized to make application for Referendum 39 funds in the approximate amount of \$213,024 to the Department of Ecology for Energy/Resource Recovery on behalf of King County;

B. The King County executive is hereby authorized to file and execute such application and enter into and execute such contracts as are required by the grantor;

C. The King County executive is also authorized to enter into and execute such subcontracts as are necessary for the implementation of the project;

D. The Department of Ecology is hereby assured full compliance with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act.
