

MOTION NO. 6443

A MOTION declaring the intention to dissolve Road Improvement District No. 70.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 3792 created Road Improvement District No. 70 for the improvement of 236th Place N.E., N.E. 180th Street, 244th Avenue N.E., N.E. 200th Street, and 236th Avenue N.E., and

WHEREAS, due to escalated costs of acquiring right-of-way, delays in construction and increased interest costs, the current estimated cost of the improvement, plus formation costs, exceeds the benefits to be derived from the improvement by the properties in RID No. 70, together with the county road fund participation, and

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed by property owners constituting 48.2% of the linear front footage and 50.29% of the area within the boundary of the improvement asking for dissolution of the district, and

WHEREAS, the clerk of the King County council referred the above said petition to the director, department of public works, and

WHEREAS, the director, department of public works, has certified that the owners currently favoring the improvement do not own property to an aggregate amount of the majority of the linear front footage upon the improvement and of the area within the limits of RID No. 70;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. It is the intention of the council to dissolve a road improvement district in King County known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 70" (hereinafter "RID 70"), and terminate the proceedings thereof.

B. It is the intention of the county council that any costs incurred to date for preliminary engineering and right-of-way acquisition will be applied to any road improvement district created in the future for the improvement of any portion of an improvement included in RID 70 to the extent such costs are for work which benefits such later improvements.

C. All persons who wish to object to or to otherwise be heard on the dissolution of Road Improvement District No. 70, are hereby notified to appear and present their objections or testimony at an open public meeting of the King County Council to be held in Room 402 of the King County Courthouse, Seattle,

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Washington at 9:30 a.m. on the 24th day of February, 1986. At such time and place, the council intends to hear such objections and testimony and to act on the intentions set forth herein.

D. The clerk of the council is hereby authorized and directed to give notice of said public hearing by publication and by mailing at the times and in the manner described in RCW 36.88.050 for publication of the resolution of intention to establish a road improvement district.
