

MOTION NO. 6447

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A MOTION requesting the county executive to prepare a plan for the disposition of land clearing and demolition debris.

WHEREAS, the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan assigns responsibility for disposal of demolition and landclearing debris to the private sector, and

WHEREAS, the Newcastle Landfill, a private operation, is presently the only available site in King County for disposal of demolition and landclearing debris, and

WHEREAS, the life of the Newcastle Landfill is uncertain and limited, and

WHEREAS, the availability of sites for the disposal of demolition and land clearing debris affects the public health, safety and welfare, and

WHEREAS, failure by the private sector to provide disposal facilities for land clearing and demolition debris would require King County and other municipalities to provide such sites, and

WHEREAS, alternatives to any private disposal site proposed for an unclassified use permit should be available in order to provide due process to citizens affected by such proposal, and

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Board for King County is about to undertake a revision of the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan, and

WHEREAS, the King County department of public works is preparing a solid waste operating plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:


The King County executive is requested to recommend policies regarding disposal of landclearing and demolition debris for inclusion in the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan.

1 The King County executive is further requested to prepare by September 1, 1986  
2 an emergency plan providing one or more alternatives for the disposal of landclearing  
3 and demolition debris which can be utilized in the event the private sector cannot  
4 or does not provide disposal sites.

5 The King County executive is further requested to incorporate into the King County  
6 Solid Waste System Operating Plan a long-term plan for disposal of demolition and  
7 landclearing debris.
