MOTION NO. 6514

A MOTION establishing a deadline for negotiation of an agreement with the City of Seattle pursuant to which City of Seattle waste will be accepted at Cedar Hills landfill.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has announced its intent to close Kent-Highlands landfill in December, 1986, and to deliver waste to Cedar Hills landfill for disposal beginning in October, 1986, and

WHEREAS, Motion 6314, adopted July 29, 1985, outlined the minimum acceptable conditions under which King County would accept disposal of City of Seattle waste at Cedar Hills landfill, and

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle has been given ample opportunity to consider and accept the conditions set forth by King County in Motion 6314, but has not done so, and

WHEREAS, King County has the authority to limit or refuse to accept City of Seattle waste for disposal at Cedar Hills landfill, or any other disposal sites in unincorporated King County, and

WHEREAS, six months is the minimum lead time necessary to make the required capital and operational arrangements for acceptance of City of Seattle waste at Cedar Hills landfill;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. King County policy related to acceptance of City of Seattle waste at Cedar Hills landfill as expressed in Motion 6314 is hereby reaffirmed.

B. King County will not accept City of Seattle waste for disposal at Cedar Hills landfill on or before January 1, 1987,

1 unless the City of Seattle has executed an agreement with King  
2 County consistent with Motion 6314 by June 30, 1986, and at least  
3 six months prior to commencing delivery of the waste.

4 C. King County will not accept City of Seattle waste for  
5 disposal at Cedar Hills landfill at any time after January 1,  
6 1987 unless the City of Seattle has executed an agreement with  
7 King County consistent with Motion 6314 at least six months prior  
8 to commencing delivery of the waste.

9 D. If the City of Seattle has not executed an agreement with  
10 King County consistent with Motion 6314 by June 30, 1986, the  
11 King County executive and the King County prosecuting attorney  
12 are hereby directed to take such legal action against the City  
13 of Seattle as may be appropriate to assure that the City is  
14 taking necessary action to secure a disposal site for their  
15 waste which is not located unincorporated King County.
