A MOTION to authorize the granting of Electrical
Distribution Relocation Easements to Seattle City Light

WHEREAS, King County, Pacific Museum of Flight, The Boeing Company and
Seattle City Light have previously agreed to relocate the electrical
distribution systems in East Marginal Way South and in vacated Purcel
Avenue South, and

WHEREAS, this relocation shall be performed by Seattle City Light, on
county owned property leased to The Boeing Company and the Pacific Museum
of Flight and shall consist of Easement A which covers the underground 27kV
and 4 vaults and Easement B which covers the pole relocation off of East
Marginal Way South, and

WHEREAS, investigation reveals that it is in the best interest of King
County to grant these easements;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The county executive is authorized to sign and deliver the necessary
electrical distribution relocation easements granting to Seattle City Light
two (2) easements for said utility relocation with all necessary or reasonable
appurtenances over, through, under, across and upon the land described in the
attachments hereto for the installation, construction, erection, alteration,
improvement, repair, energization, operation and maintenance of electrical
overhead and underground distribution facilities.
