A MOTION declaring July 21, 1986 Maple Leaf Community Council Day throughout King County.

WHEREAS, the King County Council wishes to congratulate the Maple Leaf Community Council on having Maple Leaf selected as the 1986 Neighborhood of the Year, and

WHEREAS, the Maple Leaf Community Council has demonstrated that an active community organization can have dramatic effects on what a neighborhood can become, and

WHEREAS, the Maple Leaf Community Council worked to maintain the residential character of the community and to improve the liveability of this neighborhood, and

WHEREAS, the Maple Leaf Community Council has worked with the residents of the community to survey needs, improve parks and retain the neighborhood character, and

WHEREAS, Neighborhoods U.S.A., a national organization for support of neighborhoods, has selected Maple Leaf from among 2,000 nominations as 1986 Neighborhood of the Year, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Monday, July 21, 1986 will be officially declared Maple Leaf Community Council Day, recognizing the Community Council and all of its' officers and members for their achievements and contributions to the community and King County.
