

MOTION NO. 0625

A MOTION relating to the Downtown Seattle Transit Project declaring Metro's plans to locate a transit station entrance within the King County Courthouse would create an adverse impact, and expressing the will of the Council that the station not be placed in the courthouse.

WHEREAS, the county has reassessed the impact of Metro's plans for locating a transit station entrance in the King County Courthouse, and

WHEREAS, through reassessment, the council has concluded the location of such a transit station entrance would so significantly increase pedestrian traffic through the courthouse and the administration building as to have a substantial, long-term adverse impact on county facilities, and

WHEREAS, a Metro station entrance in the courthouse would result in the loss of valuable office and storage space:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

Metro is requested to seek a location other than the King County Courthouse for its Third Avenue Metro station entrance.
