MOTION NO. 6677

A MOTION requesting the Solid Waste Division and Health Department to review methods to prevent hazardous and dangerous waste from being deposited in the King County disposal system.

WHEREAS, federal and state laws prohibit disposal of waste classified as dangerous or extremely hazardous except in specifically approved facilities, and

WHEREAS, the King County disposal system can not accept designated dangerous or extremely hazardous waste and disposal of such waste could create the risk of substantial environmental damages, and

WHEREAS, the county and other agencies including Puget Sound Council of Governments have been exploring problems of hazardous waste, and the county has contributed funding to the establishment of a regional hazardous waste collection project in the 1987 budget, and

WHEREAS, all reasonable efforts should be made to identify and implement methods and programs which would reduce disposal of dangerous and extremely hazardous waste;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED BY the Council of King County:

The solid waste division and the health department shall report to the King County council on March 1, 1987 on methodologies, programs and procedures which may be used to prevent dangerous and hazardous waste from being disposed in King County disposal facilities. Such a report should include a review of methods and programs utilized in other jurisdictions.
