MOTION NO. 6678

A MOTION requiring an agreement with the City of Kent for disposal of city solid waste at King County disposal facilities.

WHEREAS, the City of Seattle plans to close Kent-Highlands Landfill in January, 1987, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kent has indicated an intent to begin delivery of its solid waste to King County disposal facilities by January, 1987, and

WHEREAS, the City of Kent has not been a part of the King County solid waste management system which has been developed and supported from revenues generated by the system without tax subsidies, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 7708 requires any jurisdiction not using county disposal facilities by April 1, 1986, to enter into an interlocal agreement with the county for the use of those facilities before commencing delivery of waste;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

A. King County will not accept City of Kent waste for disposal at King County disposal facilities unless the City of Kent has executed an agreement with King County which has been approved by the King County Council and the Kent City Council.

B. Terms of the agreement shall at a minimum include the following:

1. Prior to first delivery of City of Kent solid waste to King County disposal facilities, the City of Kent must adopt an ordinance authorizing the county to designate disposal sites for all solid waste generated and collected within the Kent city limits, except that solid waste which is recycled.

1 2. Prior to first delivery, the City of Kent shall pay to
2 King County the cost of all equipment necessary for disposal of
3 the city's waste. The estimated cost of this equipment is
4 \$112,000.

5 3. Prior to first delivery, the City of Kent shall pay to
6 King County \$217,000 to compensate the county for the shortened
7 life of Cedar Hills.

8 4. The City of Kent shall pay the applicable disposal rates
9 as established by King County ordinance for all users of the same
10 class.
