A MOTION related to the King County Park system renaming John MacDonald Memorial Park the Tolt River-John A. MacDonald Memorial Park.

WHEREAS, via Motion 2508 the Tolt River Park was renamed John A. MacDonald Memorial Park in recognition of the organizing and volunteer efforts of Mr. MacDonald and local scouting organizations in park development, and

WHEREAS, local groups have requested that the park be renamed Tolt River-John A. MacDonald Memorial Park, and

WHEREAS, the parks and recreation division has recommended the park be renamed the Tolt River-John A. MacDonald Memorial Park because the name more accurately reflects the geographic location of the park and because the residents of King County have historically referred to the park as Tolt River Park, and

WHEREAS, renaming this park, Tolt River-John A. MacDonald Memorial Park, recognizes the Snoqualmie Indian heritage by including this Indian name as well as commemorating the major park improvements developed by Mr. MacDonald and the scouting organizations involved in the construction of the trail and shelter improvements on the west side of the park;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

John A. MacDonald Memorial Park is hereby named Tolt River-John A. MacDonald Memorial Park.
