A MOTION directing the District Court
districting committee to convene in accordance
with RCW 3.38 to consider amendments to the
District Court plan.

WHEREAS, RCW 3.38 specifies the procedures to establish or
amend a District Court plan, and

WHEREAS, the District Court plan, approved by ordinance, sets
the geographical boundaries and name of each District Court in
the county and the number of elected justices, and

WHEREAS, per RCW 3.38, the District Court plan includes the
authority to designate an administrative unit of a District
Court, established for the orderly and efficient administration
of District Court business, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to consider amendments to the
District Court plan to examine issues related to the cost of
judicial and administrative efficiency of the King County
District Court program, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to examine the boundaries of
District Courts and administrative and judicial procedures to
improve the judicial flow of cases and the management of the
same, and

WHEREAS, there is a need to examine the purpose and the
authority of the District Court's administrative unit to exercise
control over personnel, budget, and staffing of the courts based
on approved policy standards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

In accordance with RCW 3.38, the council directs that the District Court districting committee convene and consider amendments to the District Court plan.
