3 Logboom Park in his honor.

4 WHEREAS, Tracy J. Owen served as a member of the King County  
5 council from 1969 to 1980 and as chairman in 1972, and

6 WHEREAS, he was involved for more than 40 years in community  
7 service including commissioner of the King County Housing  
8 Authority; trustee of Shoreline Community College; active  
9 participant in the Shoreline Chamber of Commerce and other  
10 chambers of commerce, Kiwanis, Elks, PTSA, and YMCA; and past  
11 president of the Western States Region of the National  
12 Association of Counties and past president of the Washington  
13 State Association of Counties, and

14 WHEREAS, he was an advocate of parks and recreational  
15 facilities in the Shoreline and Northshore areas and promoted  
16 acquisition and development of King County Forward Thrust and  
17 other capital park projects in his council district including  
18 Logboom Park, the Burke Gilman Trail, the Shoreline Pool, Echo  
19 Lake Park, Hamlin Park, Shoreview Park, Richmond Beach Park, and  
20 many more, and

21 WHEREAS, he had a love of the outdoors and enjoyed outdoor  
22 activities and worked hard to make public park facilities  
23 available to all the citizens of King County;

24 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

25 The many community service contributions of Tracy J. Owen be  
26 recognized and Kenmore Logboom Park be named Tracy Owen Station  
27 in his honor.
