A MOTION authorizing the King County executive to submit an application for funding to the Washington State Department of Community Development for emergency shelters to serve youth and families.

WHEREAS, the federal government through the creation of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development Emergency Shelter Grants Program has made one hundred three thousand dollars available to the State of Washington to distribute to eligible local governments including King County for emergency shelter activities, and

WHEREAS, the State of Washington Department of Community Development has adopted guidelines for the allocation of funds and has solicited proposals from eligible local governments, and

WHEREAS, thousands of King County residents require emergency shelter because of family crisis, lack of affordable housing, unemployment and other reasons, and

WHEREAS, research performed by King County shows that the greatest need for emergency shelter exists for families and youth;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

The King County executive is authorized to submit the necessary program applications to the Washington State Department of Community Development for the Emergency Shelter Grant Program.
