A MOTION authorizing the continuation of marine law enforcement contracts between King County, and certain cities within its jurisdiction, and authorizing the County Executive to execute such contracts.

The County Executive is authorized to execute marine police service contracts attached hereto and made part of this motion with the cities of Bellevue, Hunts Point, Kirkland, Redmond and Yarrow Point for the calendar year 1987.
