A MOTION approving the sale of McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum to Cooke CableVision Inc., and authorizing the King County Executive to enter into a franchise transfer agreement transferring the control and operation of the McCaw Cablevision cable television franchises operated in King County to Cooke CableVision Inc.

WHEREAS, McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum owns and operates a cable television system in King County pursuant to King County cable television franchises numbered 565 and 979, and

WHEREAS, the cable system operated by the McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum pursuant to franchise numbers 565 and 979, was transferred by King County to McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum by Motion Number 6163, and

WHEREAS, McCaw Cablevision, Inc., has agreed to sell the assets of the McCaw Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum to Cooke CableVision Inc., and

WHEREAS, the McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum intends to cause the transfer of its King County franchises numbered 565 and 979, to Cooke CableVision Inc., a wholly owned subsidiary of Cooke Media Group Inc., which in turn is a wholly owned subsidiary of Jack Kent Cooke Inc., and

WHEREAS, upon the sale of the assets of the McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum to Cooke CableVision Inc., Cooke CableVision Inc., shall comply with the terms and conditions of franchises numbered 565 and 979. Furthermore, Cooke CableVision Inc., a subsidiary of Cooke Media Group Inc., which is a subsidiary of Jack Kent Cook Inc., unconditionally guarantees the performance of any and all obligations, terms, and conditions of said King County cable television franchises numbered 565 and 979, of which the first sheet is attached hereto and the full text of each franchise agreement, which is on file in the Office of Cable Communications of King County, is incorporated herein by reference and made a part hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT MOVED by the Council of King County:

We hereby approve of the sale by McCaw Cablevision Inc. of the assets of

1 the McCaw Cablevision Operating Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum to Cooke  
2 CableVision Inc., and we authorize the King County Executive to enter into the  
3 attached agreement consenting to the transfer of King County cable television  
4 franchises numbered 565 and 979 operated by the McCaw Cablevision Operating  
5 Partnership North Bend/Cle Elum to Cooke CableVision Inc. If, within 30 days  
6 after passage of this motion Cooke CableVision Inc. shall have failed to sign  
7 the franchise transfer agreement incorporated herein, then this approval of  
8 said sale and the agreement shall be forfeited and said transfer shall be null  
9 and void.

It further appearing that due and legal notice of said hearing on application for franchise having been posted and published in the manner prescribed by law; and

The Board of King County Commissioners having held a public hearing in respect to such application, having considered the respective interests proposed and advanced, and being fully advised in the premise does hereby find that the granting of this franchise to be in the public interest,

ORDERED by the Board of County Commissioners of King County, Washington, that there be and there is hereby granted to said

**CLEARVIEW TV CABLE, INC.,**

hereinafter called the Grantee, and to their successors and assigns, subject to all the terms and conditions hereof for the term of Twenty-Five Years from the date hereof, the right, privilege, authority and franchise for itself, its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain and operate transmission and distribution lines and/or cables for the transmitting and distributing of television, FM radio, and other audio-visual electrical signals, together with poles, and other appurtenances, upon, over, along, underneath and across all county roads and rights of way, now existing or hereafter existing, within the following-described sections, townships and range of King County:

IT IS ORDERED by the King County Council, that there be and there is hereby granted to said Cascade Radio and TV Cable

hereinafter call the Grantee \_\_\_\_\_, and to their successors and assigns, subject to all the terms and conditions hereof for the term of 25 years from the date hereof, the right, privilege, authority and franchise for itself, its successors and assigns, to construct, maintain and operate transmission and distribution lines and/or cables for the transmitting and distributing of television, FM radio, and other audio-visual electrical signals, together with poles and other appurtenances, upon, over, along, underneath and across all county roads and right of way, now existing or hereafter existing, within the following-described Sections, Townships and Ranges of King County:

- I. Township 24N. Range 8 East W.M. King County Sections 17,18,19,20,21,26,27,28,29,30,31,32, 33,34, and 35.
