2 A MOTION to set the date for a hearing upon the Maintenance
3 Assessment Roll for Road Improvement District No. 100 for
street lights within the plat of Dumas Bay Estates Number 3.

4 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance 8001 created King County Road Improvement
5 District No. 100 for maintaining, energizing and operating street lights within
6 the plat of Dumas Bay Estates Number 3: The improvement has been completed and
7 the cost is now known, and

8 WHEREAS, King County Ordinance No. 8001 directed the director of the
9 department of public works to prepare and file with the King County clerk of the
10 council, a maintenance assessment roll for the maintenance assessment to be
11 levied against the property included in Road Improvement District No. 100: The
12 maintenance assessment roll has been prepared and filed with the clerk of the
13 King County council;

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT MOVED by the council of King County:

15 A. Pursuant to the provisions of R.C.W. 36.88.090, the hearing upon the
16 maintenance assessment roll for King County Road Improvement District No.
17 100 shall be scheduled for July 6, 1987, at 9:30 a.m.

18 B. The King County council will sit as a board of equalization for the
19 purpose of considering aforesaid assessment roll at aforesaid hearing or
20 hearings and will consider such objections as are made thereto or any part
21 thereof, and will correct, revise, raise, lower, change or modify said roll or
22 any part thereof, or set aside said roll in order that such assessment be made
23 de novo as to such body shall appear just and equitable, and then proceed to
24 confirm the same by ordinance.

1 C. The clerk of the King County council is hereby directed to give notice
 2 of hearing upon said roll to all owners or reputed owners of the property whose
 3 name appears thereon by mailing a notice thereof at least fifteen days before
 4 the date fixed for the hearing to such owners or reputed owners at the address
 5 of such owner as shown on the tax rolls of the King County office of finance; in
 6 addition thereto, such notices shall be published at least two (2) times in a
 7 newspaper of general circulation in the County if the paper is published weekly
 8 or five (5) times if the paper is published daily. Such notices shall specify
 9 the time and place of hearing on said roll and shall notify all persons who may
 10 desire to object thereto to make such objections in writing and to file same
 11 with the clerk of the council at or prior to the date fixed for said hearing.
